BVRLA's e-Learning Platform Services and Access

- The BVRLA provides hosting services that allow your learners to access and use the platform via the website <u>BVRLA e-Learning Platform - Login</u>
- Only registered learners may access the BVRLA's online learning materials and the management reports.
- The BVRLA undertakes that the services will be performed with reasonable skill and care.
- The BVRLA may suspend or limit access to the services for system maintenance or other reasonable activities at any time.
- Registered Users shall use all reasonable endeavours to prevent any unauthorised access to, or use
 of, the services and in the event of any such unauthorised access or use, promptly notify the BVRLA.
- Registered Users are solely responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient and compatible hardware, software, telecommunications equipment and internet service necessary for use of the BVRLA's e-learning platform.
- Access to the e-Learning platform may be withheld or cancelled if the appropriate annual licence fees are not paid or the business discontinues its membership of the association.

BVRLA's e-Learning Subscription Annual Licence Fees

- All e-learning subscription licences run for a period of twelve months and grant access to BVRLA's e-learning material and achievement history to a single learner via the website.
- E-learning subscription licences are assigned to individuals who as registered users are given unique login details. Those log-in details may not be shared or transferred to other individuals.
- Registered Users will receive an electronic notification that their licence is due for renewal one month prior to the end of the 12-month licence period.
- Unless notified to the contrary and in writing, the BVRLA reserves the right to automatically renew the individual learner's e-learning annual subscription. This ensures continuity of access to the learning material and to the individual's learning and achievement history.
- No refunds will be given if a registered user does not fully use the e-learning service during the twelve-month subscription period or if the individual ceases to be employed by their employer.
- E-Learning subscription licences are activated from the date of invoice and not date of payment, however the e-learning content cannot be accessed until payment is received.
